Long Corner


Ball is unintentionally played over back line by a defending player

- re-start at centre-line
- in line with where the ball crossed the back-line
- the procedures for taking a free push apply
- Signal: using right or left arm as appropriate, with the arm well below shoulder level, draw an imaginary line from the point where the ball crossed the back-line to the point on the centre-line from which the re-start should be taken

Centre Line




Trapping

- It is NOT allowed deliberately to
 - Trap or press the ball against the side-boards when an opponent is in playing distance
 - Trap a player in possession of the ball by laying 'flat' sticks on the floor
 - o in the corner of the pitch (also GK)
 - against the boards
 - Trap the ball between their and an opponent's stick
- Space for an outlet pass must be left.
- Clearly unintentionally action
 - Quick bully
- Clearly deliberate action
 - intentional offence
 - penalise it accordingly



Trapping



Face Masks/Knee Pads @ PC/PS

- Face Masks
 - Transparent, single coloured, metal grill
- Knee Pads
 - Same colour as socks <u>OR</u> completely underneath normal playing clothing (socks)
- Discarded Equipment (hand protectors/knee pads/feace masks)
 - Ball hits outside ----→ free push
 - Ball hits inside ----→ PC
- It is NOT allowed
 - To play outside the circle
 - If they play outside the circle free push and if needed a card
 - o If they play after the corner is completed free push and if needed a card
- It is ALLOWED
 - To complete a defending action
 - It means that they play the ball just outside the circle when wearing face masks/knee pads to complete their defending action – NOT three moves and then a pass

Use Common Sense



Too many Players on the Pitch

- Stop time
- Correct situation
- Decisions prior correcting cannot be changed
- Re-start with PC against responsible team (no card for captain!)



Free Push 3m to the Circle

- NEW: The ball may be played into the circle off the side-boars if he travelled 3m before rebounding
- NEW: Players INSIDE the circle within 3 metres are ALLOWED to move nearer after the ball has travelled 3m before rebounded from side-boards
- NEW: After time stop ALL players (except taker) 3m



Free Push 3m to the Circle

- An attacking free pushes awarded with 3 metres of the edge of the circle will be taken from the point of the offence
 - Exactly at the point of offence
 - The ball **must** be stationary
 - Free push rule inside attacking half occurs
 - o The ball may be played into the circle off the side-boars if he travelled 3m before rebounding

Interpretation

- Players OUTSIDE the circle ----→ ALL players 3m (except the pusher)
- Players INSIDE the circle within 3 metres
 - o NO need to move away
 - NO interfering, NO playing, NO attempting to play, NO influencing the game, NO move nearer after umpires stopped the game
 - ALLOWED to shadow around the circle inside
 - ALLOWED to move nearer, interfere after
 - ❖ ball has moved 3m
 - another player has touched the ball
 - the ball has travelled 3m before rebounded from side-boards
- Players INSIDE the circle more than 3 metres ----→ Setup at the moment umpires stopped the game
 - o NO move nearer then 3m before the ball is played
- After time stop
 - o ALL players (except taker) 3m
